Mission Work

- In Haiti: Construction work in the mornings, other ministry work in the afternoon based on team's skills
- At Home: Collecting items to bring. If there is interested, it would be possible to involve our partner congregations/schools in this mission by collecting specific items that are needed in Haiti such as humanitarian kits, infant clothes, etc.

- \$1500-1700 (down payment of \$500 due by April 15 to confirm slot)
- Vaccinations (Typhoid, Hepatitis A & B or Twin Rex combo, Meningitis, Tetanus, Polio booster, Flu shot, Malaria pill series)
- Valid passports
- Small amount of spending money if individuals want to purchase souvenirs, soda, etc.
